Code of conduct for young people and vulnerable adults

GYGYC expects all young people and vulnerable adults attending the Peer support groups to work with the staff members and the Board of Trustees to ensure they follow the requirements below when they are involved with the organisation.

At the beginning of each year the staff team will work with the young people and vulnerable adults attending each Peer support group to set the ground rules and behaviour contract they will include the following points.

The behaviour contracts once agreed in their groups will need to be signed during their induction process/period, after reading and understanding.

GYGYC staff and volunteers will ensure that young people go to the toilet one at a time during the Peer support meetings.

During the Yellow Peer Support group, a member of staff will stand in the corridor while young people use the toilet to ensure the young people and other members of the public are safe. Boys are to use the disabled toilet during sessions.

I WILL

- Treat everyone how I would like to be treated
- Ensure that welfare and safety is paramount at all times
- Respect everyone- including other children, young people, vulnerable adults, staff and volunteers
- Follow behaviour contract
- Speak to staff and volunteers if I have any worries
- Have FUN during activities, trips and workshops
- Set behaviour ground rules in session and keep to them
